#### Job description:

### **Job responsibilities:**

- Physically manage the company's stock of currently ~2500 compounds.
- Maintain quality control of stock using techniques including NMR and LC-MS.
- Replenishment of laboratory chemicals, solvents, and consumables to the predefined cells within the laboratory and requested site areas.
- Prepare customer and other outgoing shipments ready to be collected.
- Manage incoming shipments.
- Stock check of consumables store, ordering, labelling of incoming goods, and restocking of shelves including stock rotation.
- Daily collection and disposal of:
  - Contaminated and non-contaminated sharps and glass waste.
  - Hazardous and non-hazardous solvent waste from laboratory fume cupboards.
  - Hazardous and non-hazardous samples post analysis.
- Daily cleaning of laboratory glassware and restocking of cupboards with cleaned glassware.
